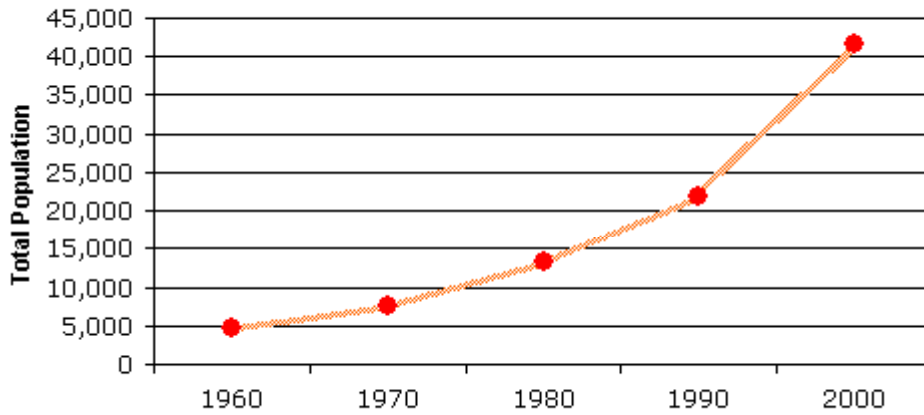

## Population, 1960-2000

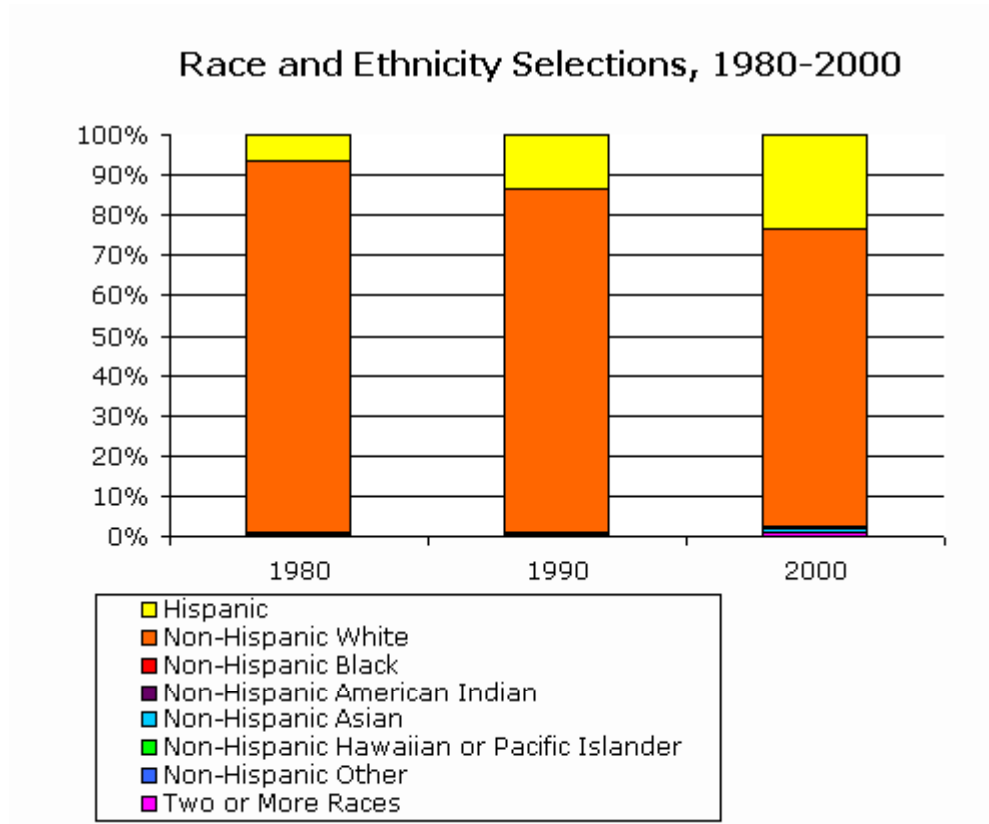

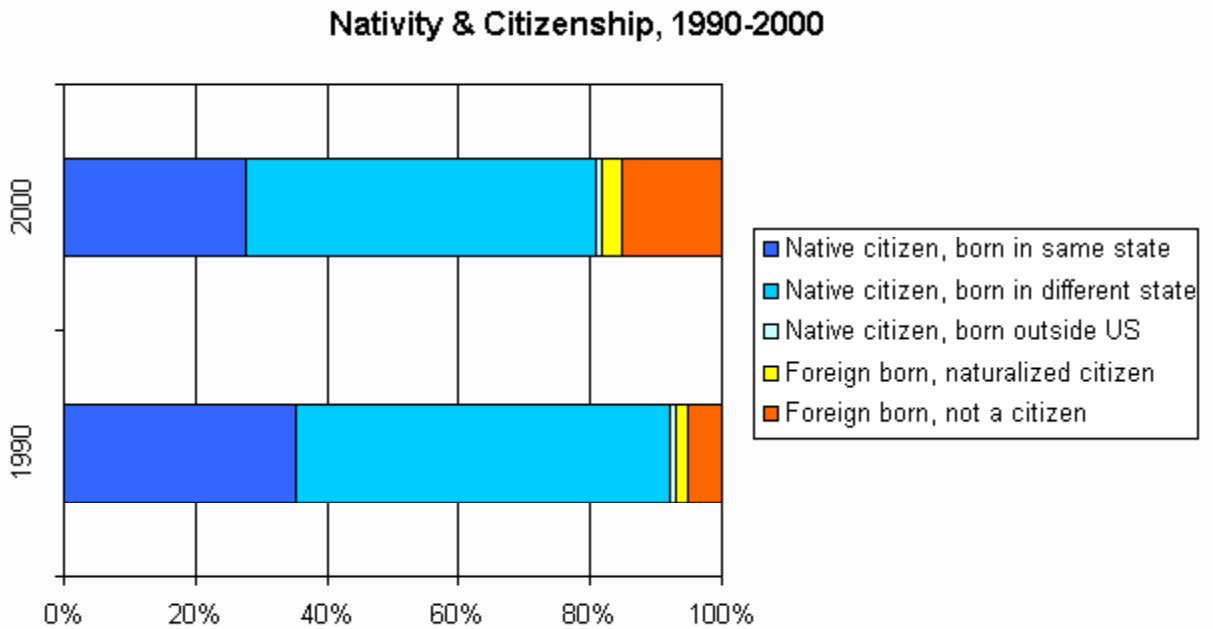

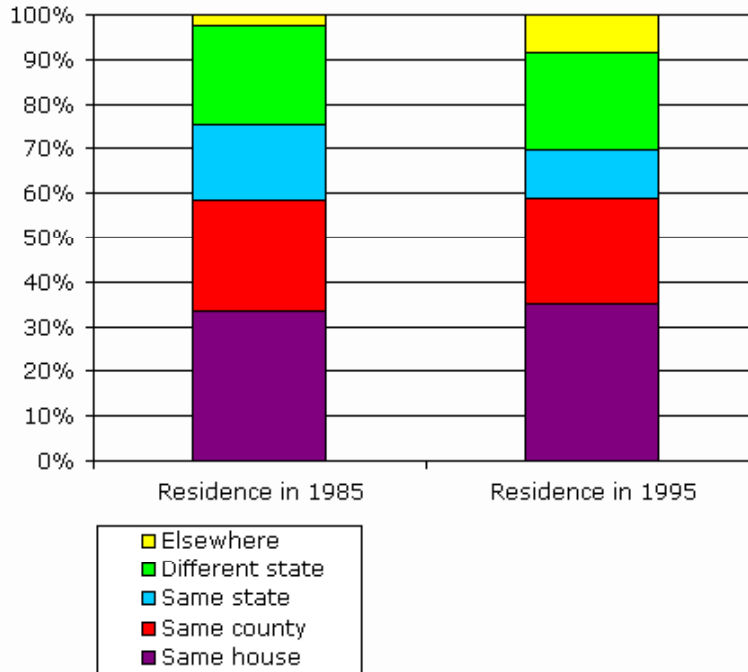

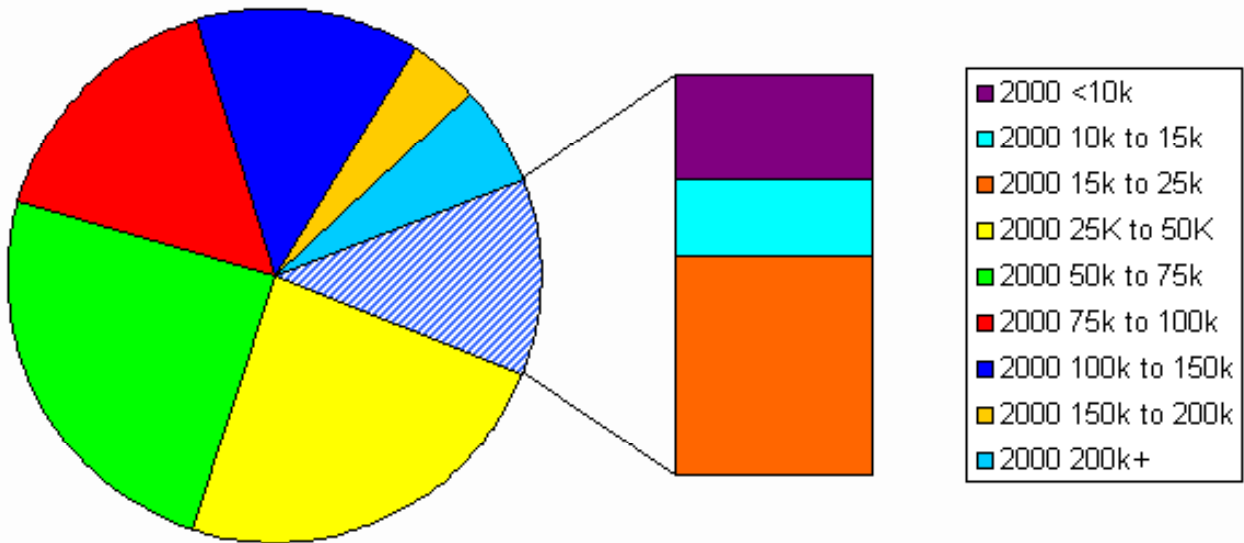

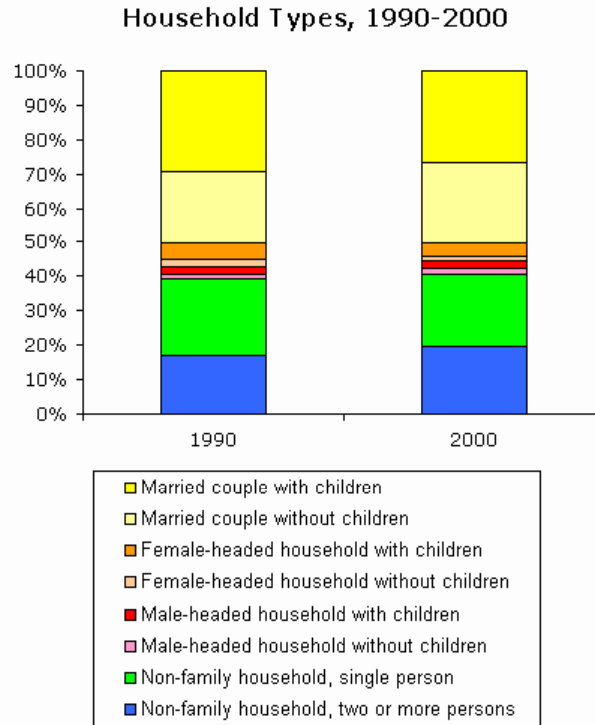

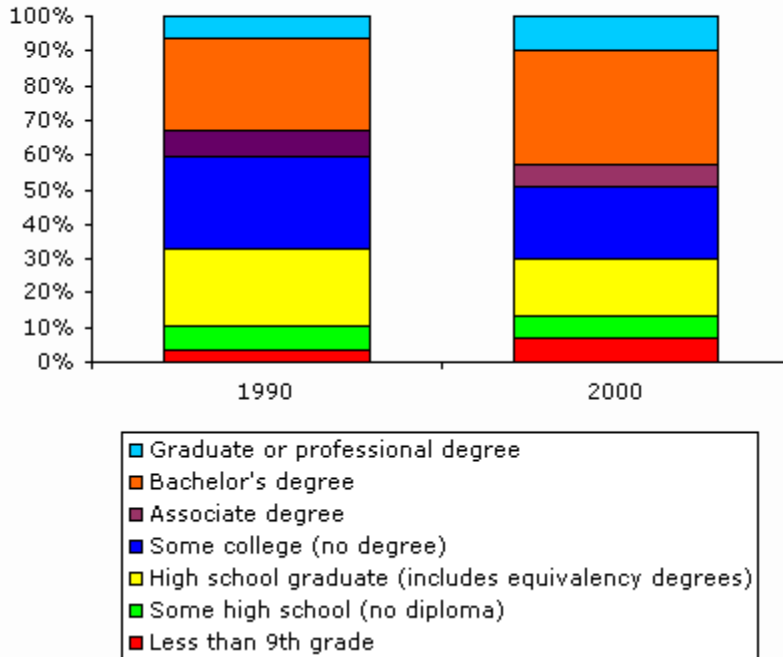

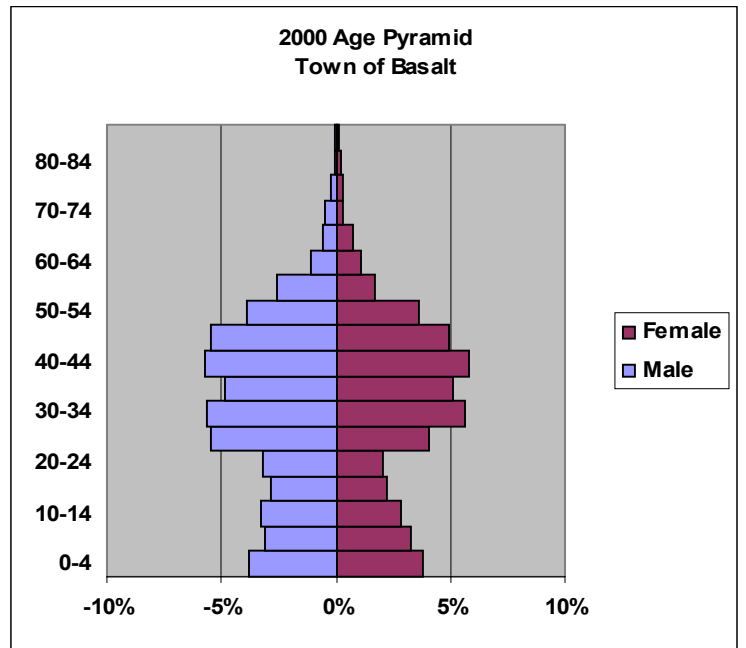

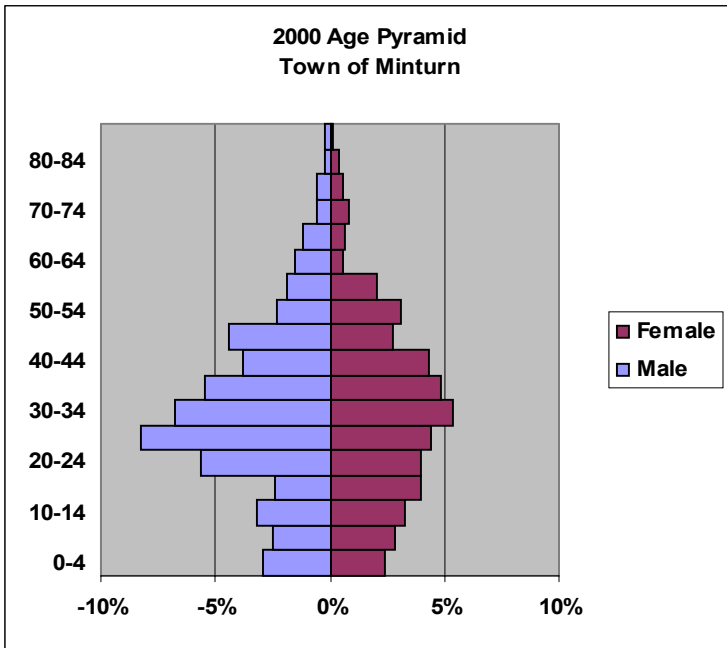
