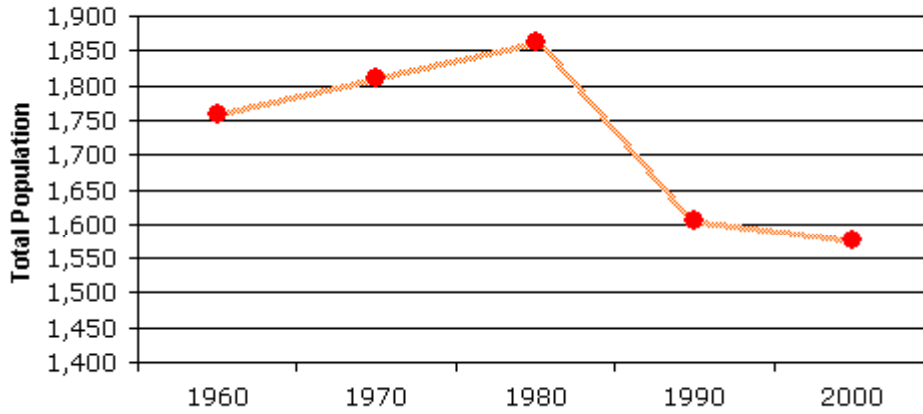

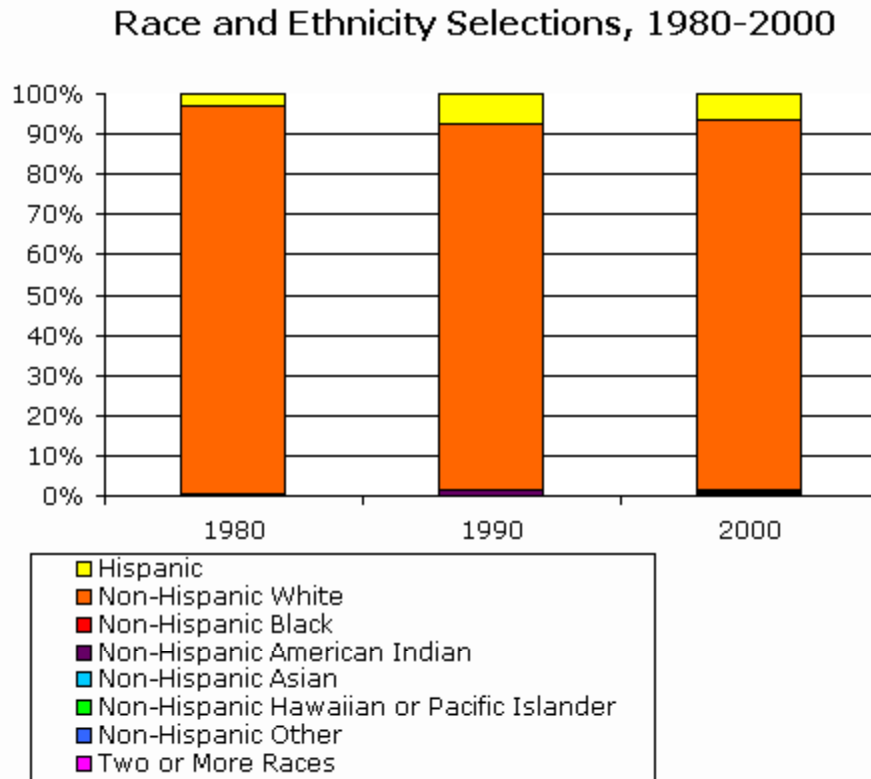

Hispanic Population and Race Distribution for Non-Hispanic Population

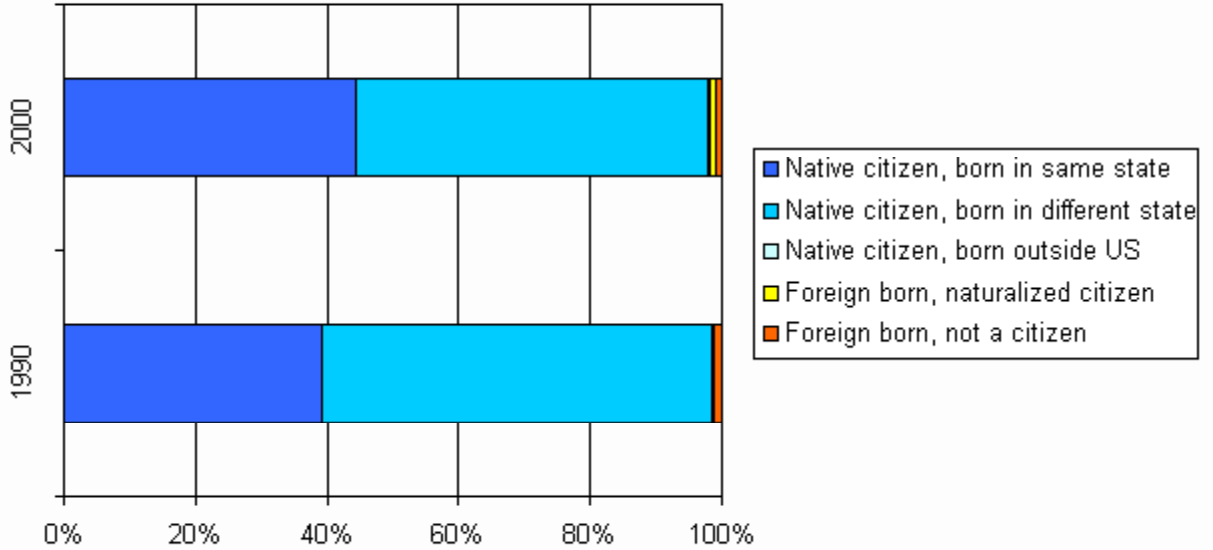

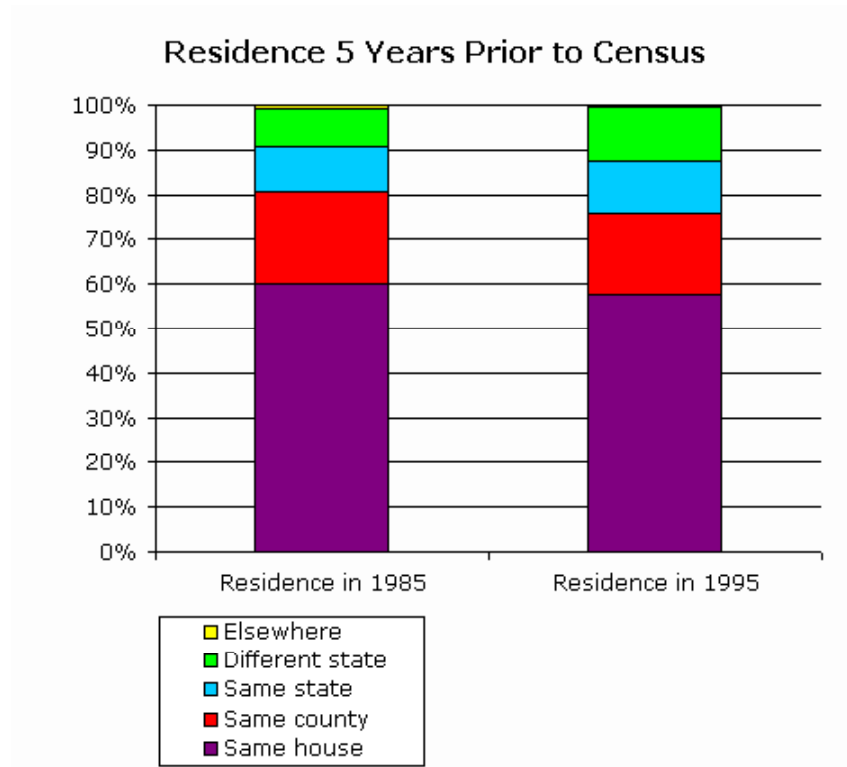

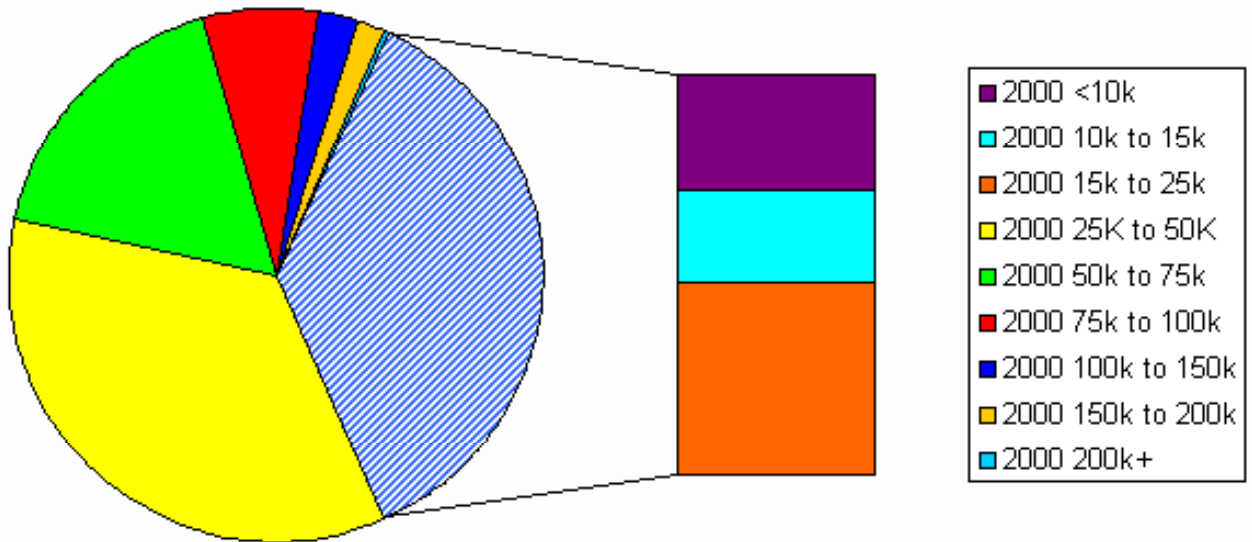

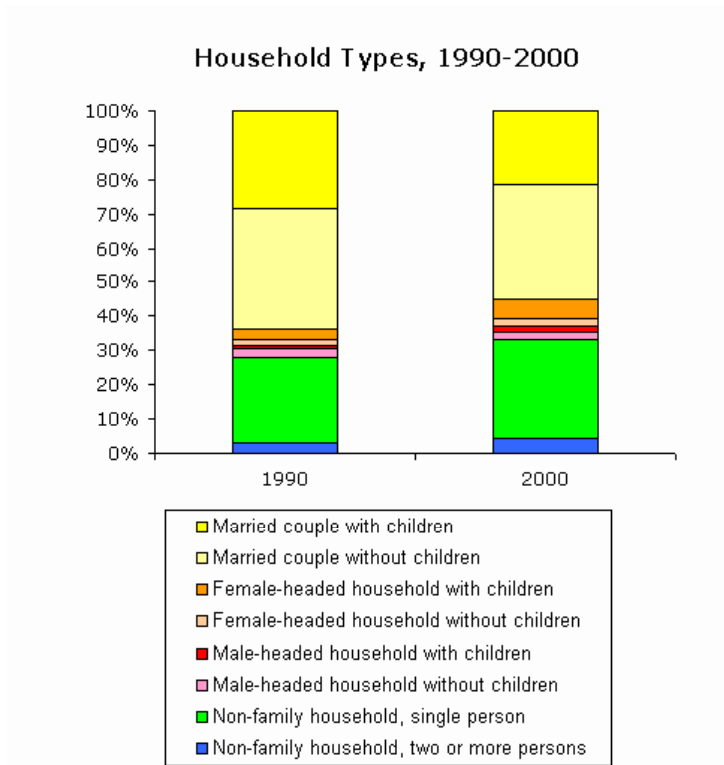

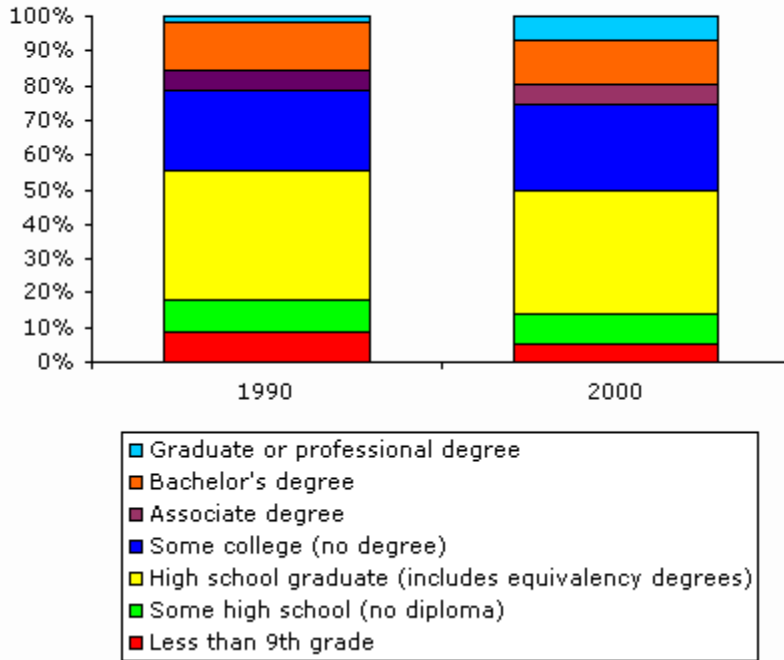
