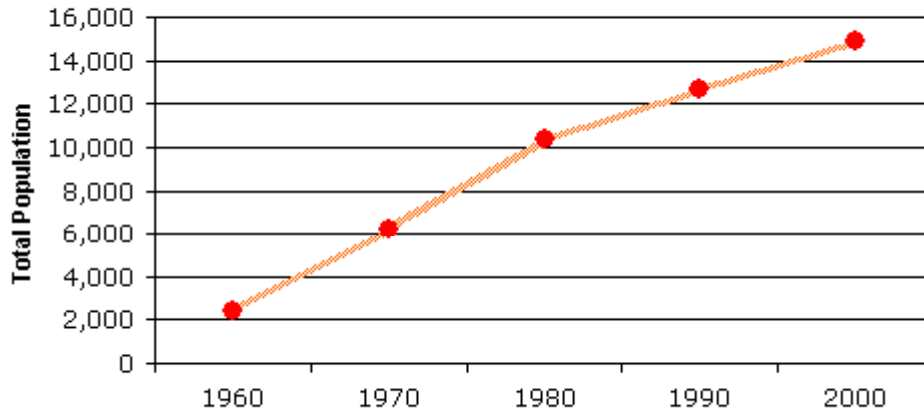

## Population, 1960-2000



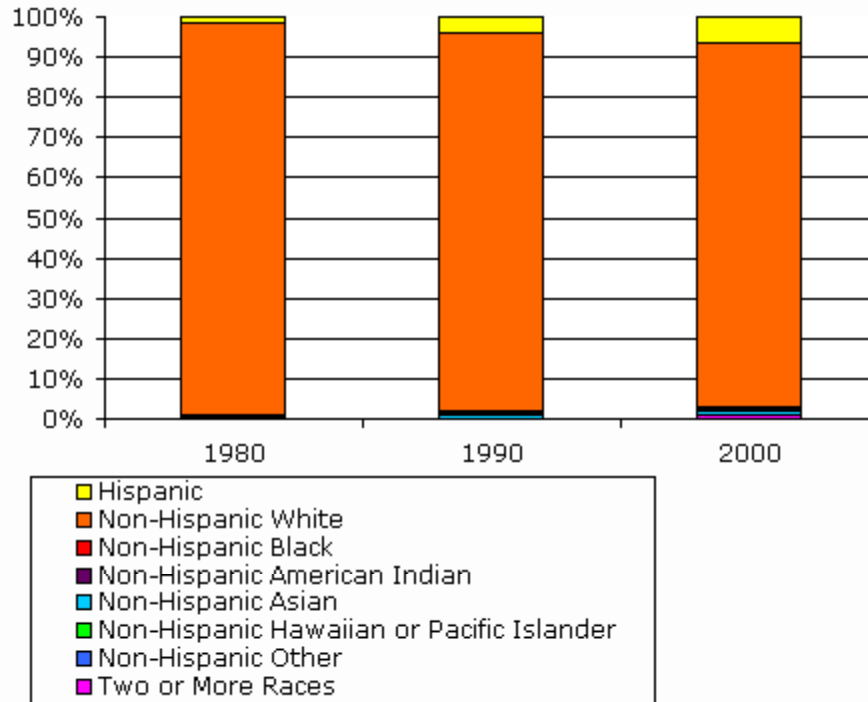

Race and Ethnicity Selections, 1980-2000



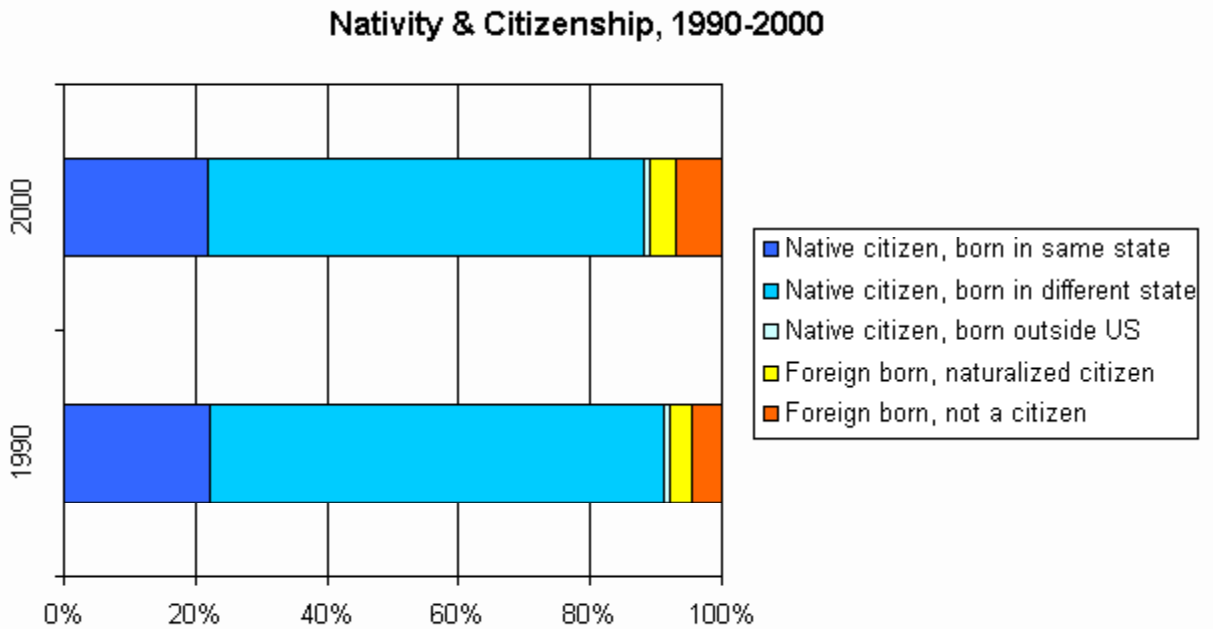

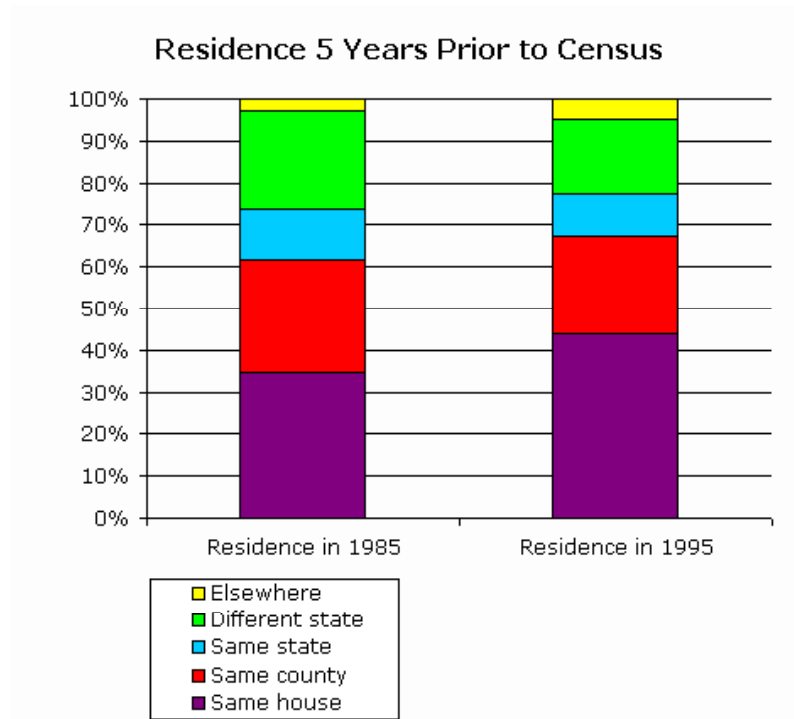

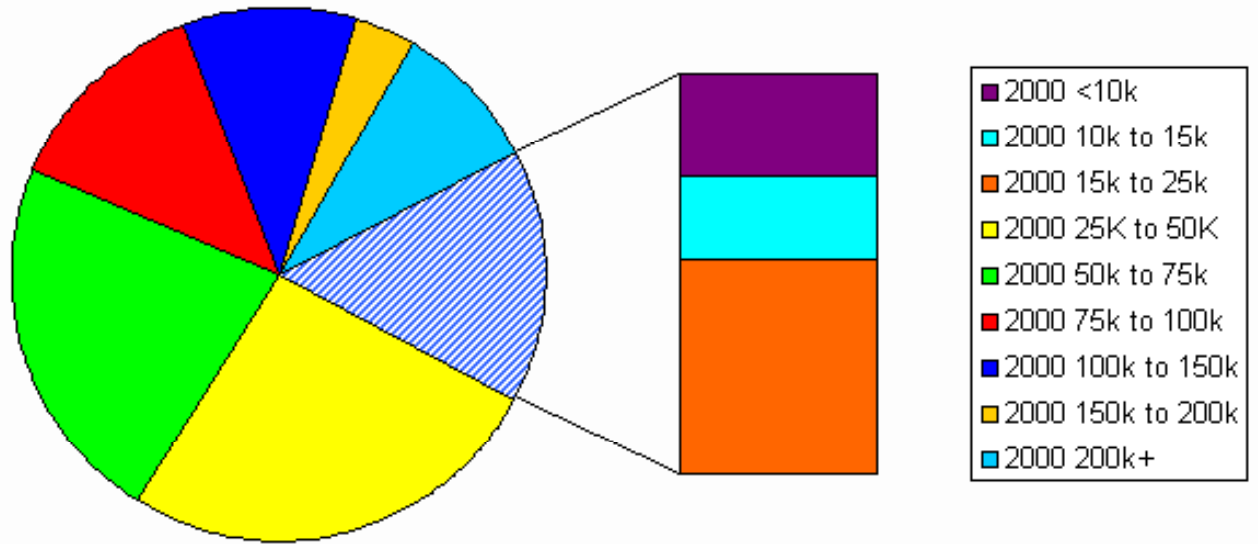

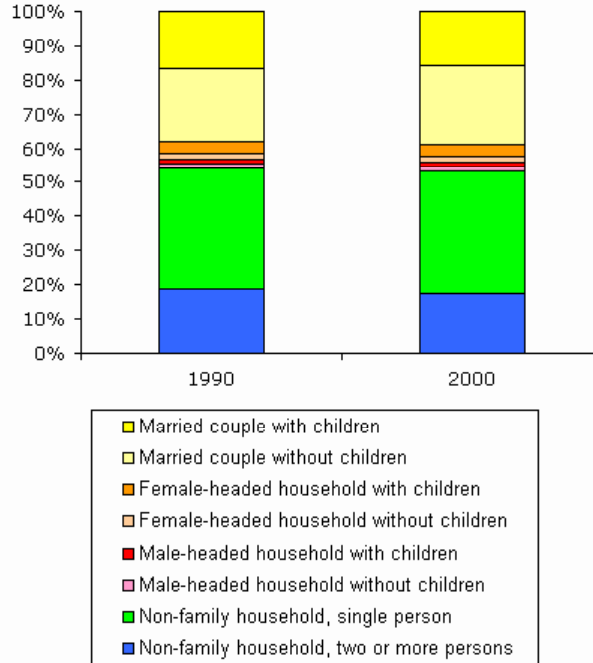

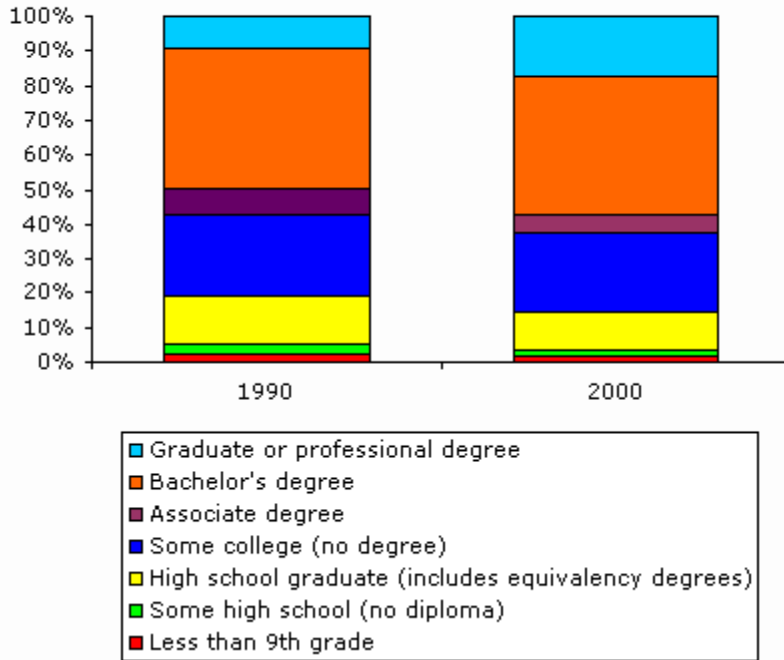
