Roaring Fork Transportation Authority (RFTA)

The Roaring Fork Transportation Authority or RFTA has been in operation since 1983. Serving the Roaring Fork Valley, RFTA has an operation area covering Aspen, Snowmass Village, Pitkin County, Basalt, a portion of Eagle County, Carbondale and New Castle.

- Approximately 5.1 million system wide trips since 1983
- 5.3 Million miles operated
- 70 Mile service region
- Named “Large Transit Agency of the Year” by the Colorado Association of Transit Agencies
- 160 Total Bus stops serviced
- 380 peak employees sustaining operation of approximately 90 busses including zero emission vehicles
