# Presentation: Town of Vail's E-Courier Program

Presenters: David Riddle, Principle, 106 West Logistics; Commander Ryan Kenney, Town of Vail Police Department

The E-Vail Courier Program has been implemented in the Town of Vail's Vail Village and Lionshead to increase the safety of pedestrians, improve the guest experience, and reduce environmental impacts caused by vehicular traffic in pedestrian mall areas. This program is a delivery system that addresses these issues and provides for the coordinated and efficient delivery of commercial goods in Vail Village. The program includes use of town-owned electric carts to make deliveries from the Mountain Plaza loading dock to storefronts in Vail Village's pedestrian area while strictly limiting access by other vehicles.
