### RTCC and IMTPR Project Updates

#### Summit County's Transit Fleet Storage, Charging and Operations Facility Project

A completely new facility (pictured above) that combines fleet storage, electric charging, bus operations, and now also is planned to include 10 units of employee housing. We received a federal grant for \$34.7M and will be funding the remaining 20% of the project budget with county funds and/or other grant opportunities. The total project cost is projected to be \$42M.

#### Potential Microtransit System for Summit County

The Summit Board of County Commissioners met with Breckenridge Town Council on Feb. 27 to discuss the possibility of creating a countywide microtransit system that would provide public transportation to more residential areas throughout the county.
