Steamboat Springs Transit (SST)

Steamboat Springs Transit provides free fixed route bus services between Steamboat Springs and Craig. Steamboat Springs Transit or SST for short, has been serving the city of Steamboat Springs since 1981. In their peak season, Steamboat Springs Transit employs

approximately 60 personnel to transport around 8,000 people daily.

During the winter, Steamboat Springs Transit runs six different lines during the day, two lines at night and three different lines over the summer. This results in over one hundred bus stops. These bus routes help the residents and visitors of Steamboat Springs to get virtually anywhere in town for free.

- Approximately 1.1 million system passengers since 1981
- 620,000 Miles serviced annually
- 19 buses at peak with 2 paratransit shuttles
- 45,000 annual hours of service (23 hours a day in winter season)
- 60 peak employees
- Ninth largest transportation system in Colorado
