Why we got here

- Numerous outages across region completely cut off communities
- Impacted governments, schools, businesses and public safety......
- Existing providers didn't deliver reliable, affordable middle mile
- Non-competitive pricing compared to Front Range



Rural Broadband Realities

- Broadband is essential for education, economic development and public safety
- Rural Colorado is underserved
- Rural communities need broadband to survive and flourish
- Each community is unique customized solutions required
- Regional and last mile approaches both needed
- Public Private Partnerships necessary



Successful Program Strategies

- > Middle Mile Focus
- Support Last Mile ISPs
- Meet regional and community needs
- > Tailored local solutions
- Close the broadband gap in more communities



Project THOR Network

- 9 Counties, 16 rural towns and cities
- Serves local governments, community anchors and last mile ISPs
- Network peak daily traffic has increased from 5G to 32G
- > 17,121 Sq Miles
- > 233,191 people
- > 13.6 people/sq mile



R10 Today

- ▶ 6 Counties, 18 Communities
- ▶ 18 CNL's (14 online, 4 in development)
- ▶ 600 Miles of Fiber
- Access to 14 Meet-Me Centers via Project THOR
- Expansion throughout Western Colorado



Statewide Perspective

- State of CO pop 5,812,069
 - > 104,185 square miles
 - > 55.7 people/sq mile
- Denver Metro Area pop 2,963,821
 - > 5470 square miles
 - > 344 people/sq mile




Project THOR + Region 10 Delivers

- More access in more places
- Broke lock that inflexible national ISPs had on our communities
- Flexibility allows communities the ability to roll with changing needs
- Bandwidth costs reduced \$1.10/M to sub \$0.25/M
- Resilience helps reduce outages
- Support multiple smaller last mile ISPs

CO Funding Matrix

- ▶ DOLA Planning and Infrastructure Grants – 50/50 match
- ARPA CPF funding is coming to local communities with a broadband use call out (CBO Managed)
- IIJA funding is in Treasury rulemaking
 Broadband Equity \$100 \$500M
 (CBO Managed)
- Colorado Broadband Fund assists provider innovations in last mile infrastructure deployment
- ► CAF, RDOF, ReConnect, USDA
