




Q1: Do you represent a municipality or county?





Q2: Are you an elected official or staff?







69.23% agreed publishing reports from original research is important to indispensable

71.43% find the monthly newsletters with From the Directors Desk important to indispensable

Over half of responses rated facilitating retreats low to some importance

More than 90% agreed that sharing stories/data with other jurisdictions has some importance to indispensable

Three quarters believe advocating for region at state/national level is important to indispensable

78.57% find regional leadership on federal land management issues important to indispensable

64.29% agreed that managing complex grants and services on behalf of membership important to indispensable


