



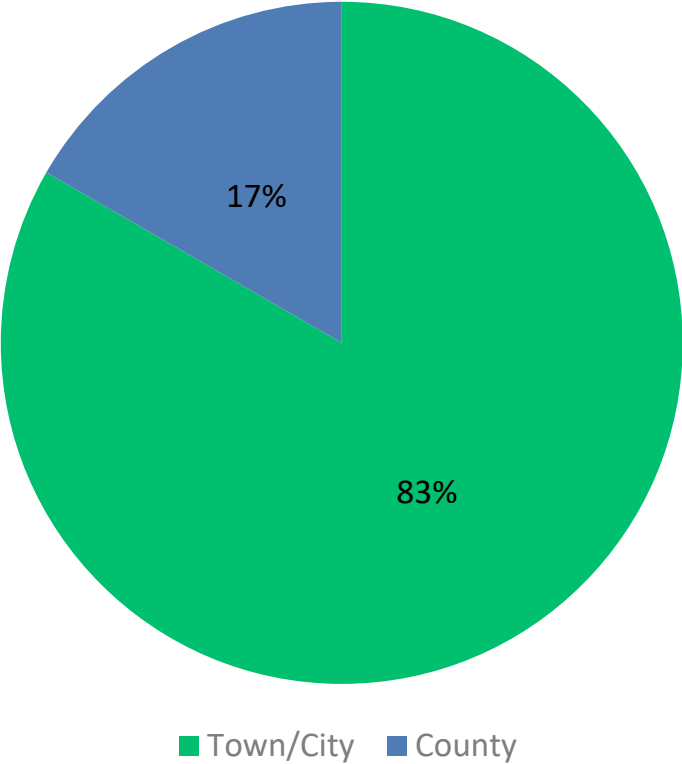

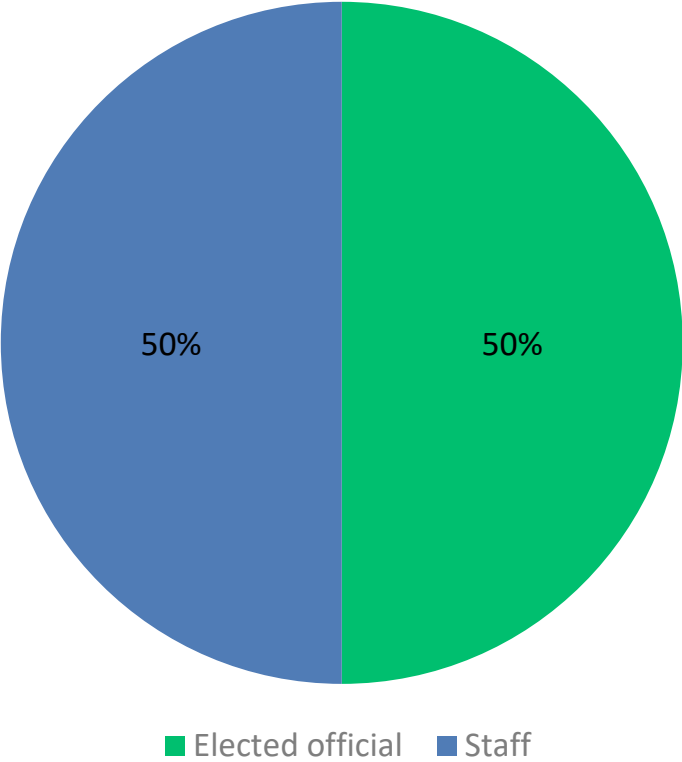
Q1: Do you represent a municipality or county?

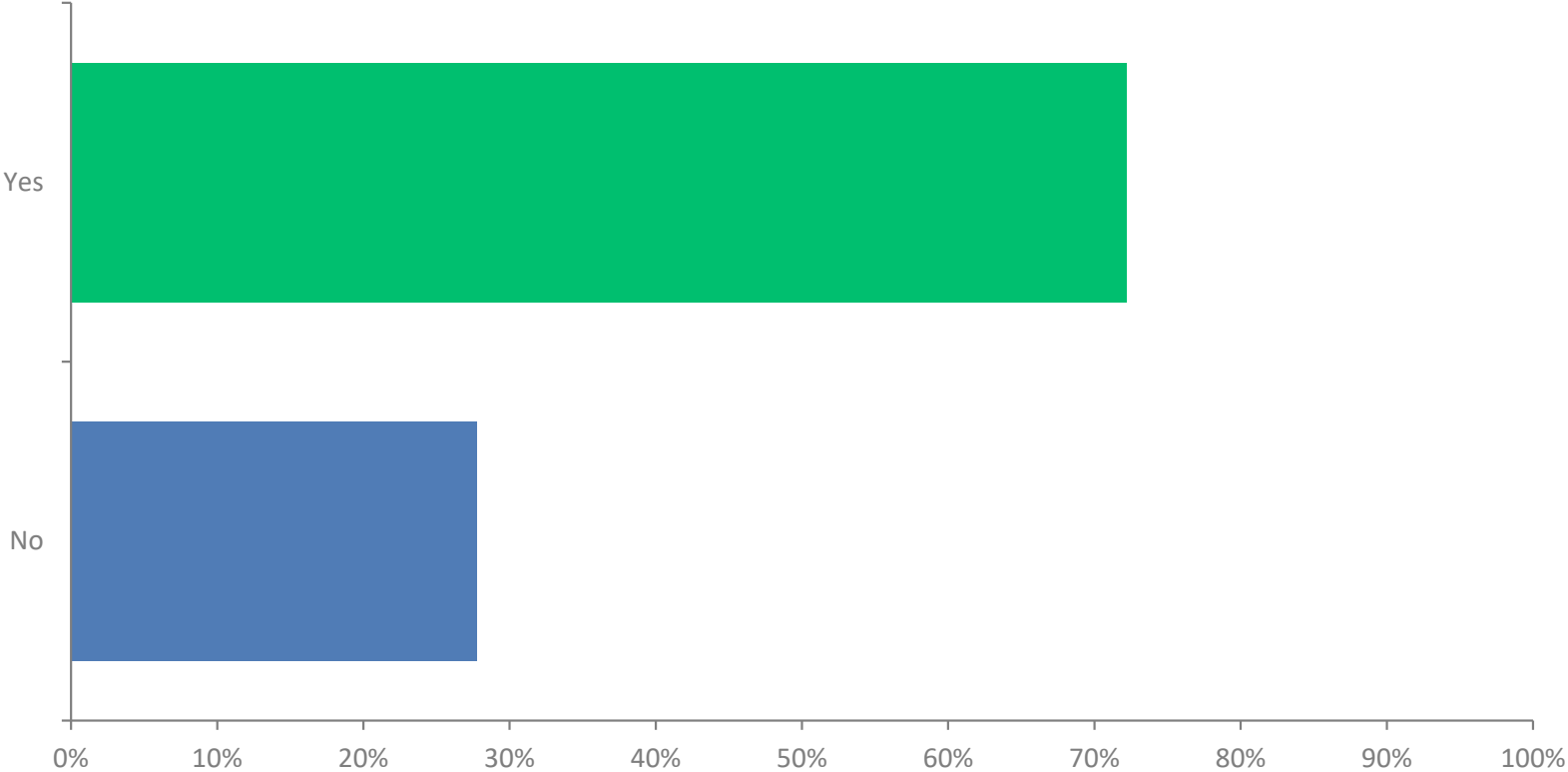

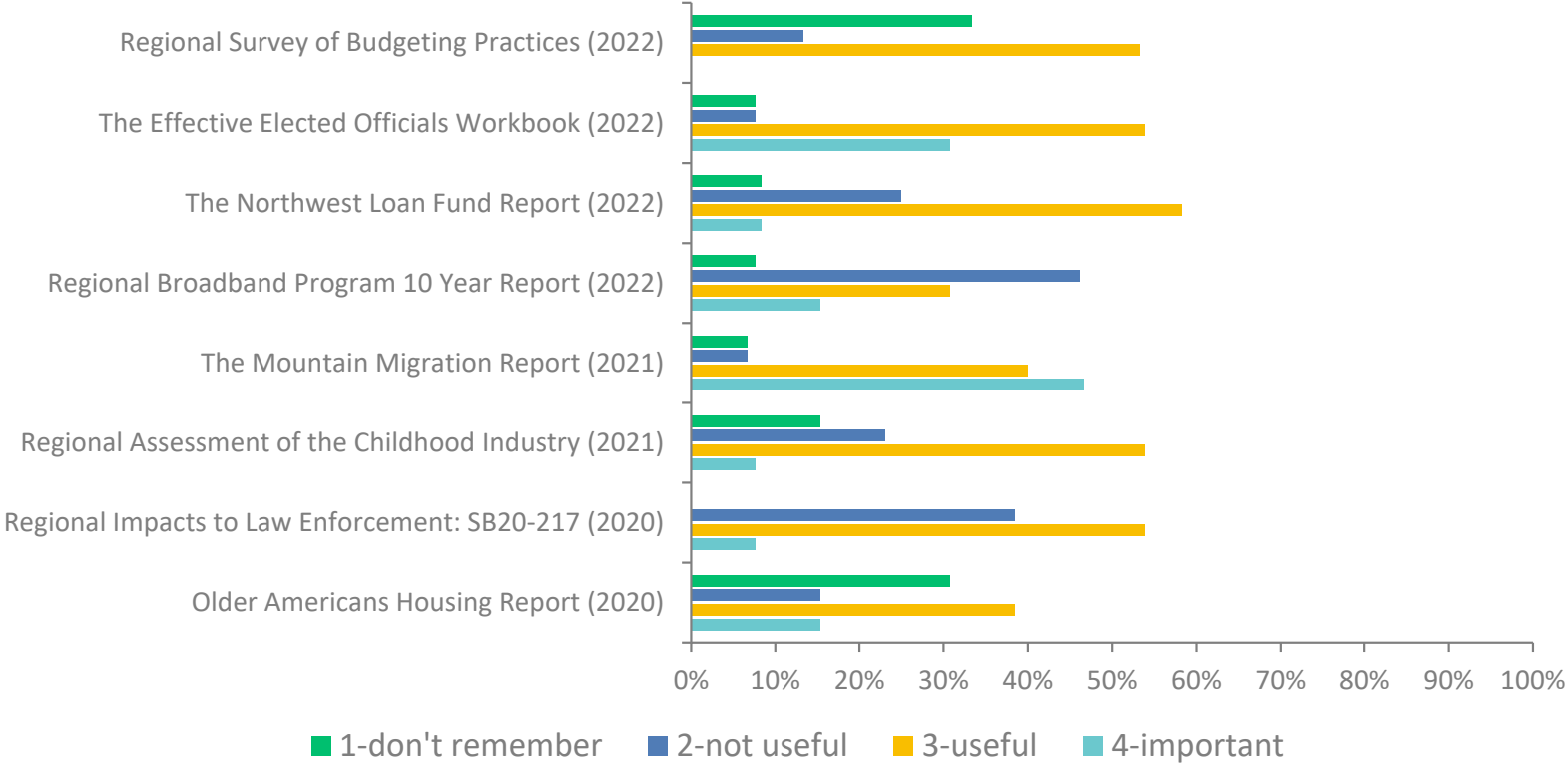

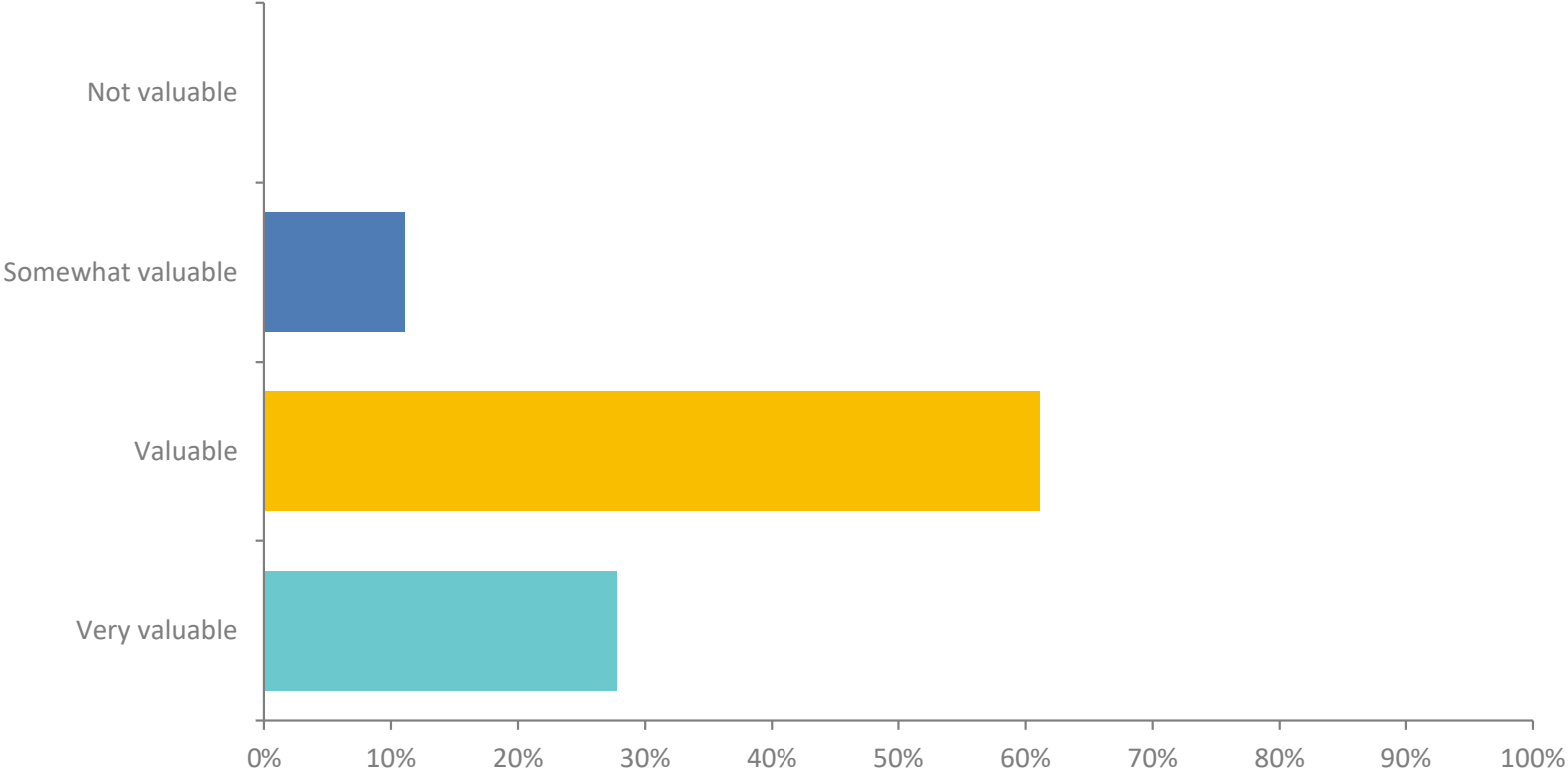
