  - strive toward a more perfect union.

# What Can Commemoration Look Like?

Activities can include, but are not limited to:

- Historical activities
- Creation and publication of historical documents
- Preservation of historic sites, art, artifacts
- Promotion of scholarship and research that illuminates the history of the American West and Colorado, within the larger story of the United States
- Arranging public ceremonies and commemorative events
- Identifying local opportunities for commemoration
